

Sask DLC's Got Talent – Call for Entries!

Dear Students,

Yes, it's time for the **Sask DLC's Got Talent Show and we want you to be in it!** Show (or shows!) will be broadcast the week of Nov. 6th. All sorts of school appropriate talents are welcome -- serious, funny, and quirky!! Last year's show had everything from songs to juggling to card tricks to memorizing the first 100 digits of pi!

- Creations – e.g. art, Lego, the awesome fort I built this summer
- Physical talents – e.g. Rubik's cube, blowing a really huge bubble, trick shot, dog tricks
- Performance – e.g. music, magic act, comedy, dance
- Surprise us!

Entry Rules:

- Be parent-approved, including safety and content.
- Be school appropriate
- Have a permission form from each participant
- Be under 2 minutes (so might just have to be PART of a song)
- Include at least one Sask DLC student
- Be uploaded to YouTube

Interested? Here's how you enter:

- **Upload** your demo video to YouTube as an unlisted video. Copy the link.
- **Complete** the [Participant Form](#) by Monday, Oct. 23rd. You will paste the video link in this form.
- **Complete** the [Permission Form](#) for each participant (child or adult) by Mon., Oct. 23rd.
- **Wait** for a response from us. We will get back to you by Wed., Oct. 25th with information.
- **Share** your final performance video by Wed., Nov. 1st. (Or just tell us to use your demo video.)
- **Attend the following meetings:**
 - a 10- minute "meet and greet" with one of our hosts some time the week of Oct. 30th.
 - Wed, Nov. 1st @ 10:00 to 11:00 (1st practice)
 - Mon., Nov. 6th (technical rehearsal) and Tue., Nov. 7th (dress rehearsal) -- time TBA

FAQ's

What will the show's format be?

Just like other talent shows, we will introduce you to our audience, preferably with a short, fun live interview with you. Then we will play your recorded submission.

Is this a competition?

No, this is a showcase of talent!

Why only two minutes?

We want to give as many people a chance to show their talent as possible. If your piece is longer than two minutes, please let us know the two minutes that you would like showcased.

Can others perform with me?

Yes, if your talent is a group performance with others who are not Sask DLC students, you are still welcome to submit. A permission form will need to be signed by them/their parents. Note, though, that we will be interviewing YOU.

What will you ask me in the interview?

Apart from your first name and grade, YOU get to tell us what to talk about, such as how you learned that skill or what you enjoy about it, or why you chose that selection. We'll keep this short and simple, but you can also choose not to be interviewed. No other personal information will be shared.

How do I showcase something I've created?

If you have an amazing Lego or art construction, you might want to show us the finished product and explain in the video how you did it or show us some of the parts.

Who will see my performance?

Anyone who attends the talent show will see your performance, as well as potentially your class if your teacher shares it in a class meeting. It may also be shared on our our SaskDLC social media.
